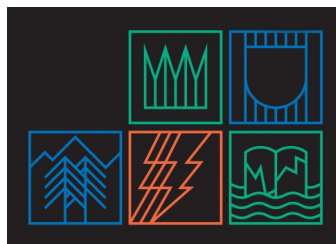
School of the Arts is looking for donations:
