REFLECT

1. What lesson was God teaching Israel when He reminded them of His mighty acts of judgment against Egypt? To whom was he speaking? V2
2. What message was God sending to Israel by reminding them of this episode of rebellion that took place in the wilderness? (see Num 16) How is this relevant for church today? (Read 1 Cor 10:1-13)
3. What would be key to Israel's success and ability to possess the land? V.8-9
4. How did Moses contrast and compare Egypt with the promised land? (vs.10-12) Discuss the differences as well as their spiritual significance.
5. To what degree would God care for his people? (12, 13-15) Discuss the significance of the early and latter rains to Israel. In which way does this apply to the church? (John 4:13, 7:37, Romans 5:5, Acts 2:17-18)
6. Why were the people of God given this word of caution? (v.16-17)
7. Why did Moses charge the people of God to pay close attention to the word of God? (v.26+) (Josh 1:8) (James 1:25) (John 15:5-11)

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
