REFLECT

1. Read Isaiah 9:5-7; Jeremiah 23:5-8; Psalm 110; Psalm 89:19-29. Based on these passages how possible is it that some of the Jews of Jesus' day could have misunderstood these verses as referring to a political/military Messiah? Explain your answer.
2. Why would it have been strange for King David to call his son or one of his descendants "...my Lord"? What does it suggest about the person of the Messiah? See Philippians 2:5-11
3. How was it possible that the Messiah was both David's descendant and greater than David? See Romans 1:3-4.
4. Why do you think Jesus so abruptly turns His attention to the warning against the rulers in vv.45-47? How is it connected to vv.41-44?
5. What are the main things that Jesus warns the people about their leaders?
6. Why do you think they will be judged more severely in v.47? See James 3:1.
7. The story at the beginning of chapter 21:1-4 is actually connected to our text by its theme of a poor widow. How is Jesus contrasting her with the religious rulers?
