For the second time in the last few months, we have received a discouraging call informing us that our rental contract must be cancelled by invoking the law of secularism as the reason for termination. Which means this will be our last Sunday celebrating at our current location.

We believe that in this case, the City of Saguenay is overstepping its authority and using it to discriminate. We also believe that we have been placed in this time and in this city to be a light in the darkness. Furthermore, we are convinced that darkness will not overcome the light of the Gospel. Therefore, as always, we will react according to our beliefs.

We invite you to respond in prayer with us:

-that the Lord would protect us and our church from responding in the flesh. Protect us from sinning against God, each other and our neighbours who are against us (against anger and resentment specifically).

-the tension for Aaron and Zach between shepherding our people well and standing firm in their convictions that this is a cause worthy of a fight to protect the future of church planting in the province.

-for our daily bread. We once again have a physical need for a gathering space.
