Acts 22:22-23:1-31

1st RESCUE: OUTSIDE THE TEMPLE (21:27-40)

- The Asian Jews saw Paul inside the Temple.
- They accused him of blasphemy and defiling the temple.

2nd RESCUE: FROM FLOGGING (22:22-29)

- Paul was taken up into the Roman Barracks (The Antonia Fortress) where he was to be flogged.
- Paul questioned a centurion standing by if it was lawful for a Roman citizen to be flogged "uncondemned"?
- He used his citizenship as a means to escape the illegal flogging.

3rd RESCUE: BEFORE THE SANHEDRIN 22:30-23:11

- The high priest commanded a soldier to smite Paul.
- Paul predicted that God would smite him. (V.3)
- The Sadducees and the Pharisees begin to squabble.

4th RESCUE: FROM A PLOT TO KILL HIM (23:12-22)

- 40 men took an oath not to eat or drink until Paul was dead! (V.12)
 They planned to assassinate him.
- Paul was delivered once again.

- 40 men took an oath not to eat or drink until Paul was dead! (V.12) They planned to assassinate him.
- Paul was delivered once again.
